### CAMPOREE REGISTRATIONS

**Cancellations:** Please note that cancellation of registrations will attract an administration fee.

**Cut-offs:** Registrations will close at midnight on December 16th. No registrations will be accepted after this day.

**Restrictions:** Unregistered people will not be allowed onsite.

**Bulk Payments:** If your club is paying in bulk, all registrations and payments must be made BEFORE the end of the fee period to take advantage of that rate. All registrations made after the cut-off will default to the new pay rate.

### REGISTRATION DAY 1<sup>ST</sup> JANUARY 2019

**Arrival Times:** There will be allocated arrival times on registration day, which you will receive in due course. This schedule must be strictly adhered to for registration to occur smoothly.

**Vehicles:** All vehicles from a club must arrive at registration at the same time to receive their entry pass. All cars without an entry pass will be turned away and will need to obtain an entry pass before entering the site.



### SISTER CLUBS

Are you from outer regions of Australia and need a little assistance with getting all your gear over to Molesworth? Perhaps you could contact your Conference Youth Director to pair you up with a sister club that is more local.

### FOOD STORE

A camporee food store will be set up so clubs can pre-order items during December, and then collect onsite. Such items will include perishable fruit, veggies, bread, ice, milk, ice cream and drinks etc.

### GENERATOR CURFEW

Generators will have curfews at 10pm. We ask that clubs think of their neighbours, and be considerate of noise and fumes from their generators.
