Greetings Pathfinder Directors and Staff,

**CAMPOREE MARCHING DISPLAY - CLUB INFORMATION**

The Camporee Parade and Marching event team would like to extend an invitation to all Pathfinder clubs, who enjoy marching and creative marching, to consider joining the marching display at the upcoming Unstoppable Camporee.

Following the success of the marching display/contests at previous camporees, the Parade Team is keen to include such an activity as part of the program again this time. So, without further delay, we would like to encourage clubs to take time to plan and practice their diagrams.

Due to the busy daily program the marching contest will be conducted in heats during the 'free periods' of each day. Typically, this could be during the lunch or tea break. Clubs are invited to enter a team to demonstrate their marching skill across two disciplines: 1/ Test Diagram and 2/ Own Choice Diagram.

The team requirements are similar to previous events:

- Each team will consist of a minimum of nine (9) members, and up to a maximum of fifty per cent (50%) of club members.
- Team members will be of Pathfinder age (i.e. Friend to Guide) plus one staff member, i.e. instructor/leader.
- The team will not include Junior Counsellors or club staff.
- Bonus points will be allocated if the team is led by a person under eighteen (18) years of age.

Each team will be allowed a maximum of five (5) minutes to complete the test diagram and the same amount of time to complete their own-choice diagram.
